Founded in 1903, McLean Contracting Company (McLean) is one of the leading Heavy Civil and Marine Contractors on the East Coast. McLean continues to bring peace of mind to those we serve by offering safe and exceptionally high standards of service with a multitude of capabilities that reach far beyond marine construction.

McLean is structured as a 100% Employee Owned "S" Corporation with our corporate headquarters located in Glen Burnie, MD. McLean presently operates in 5 states with over 280 employees, and maintains regional offices and construction yards in Baltimore, MD and Chesapeake, VA. McLean also operates a full-service marine terminal, and upland dredge material treatment and disposal facility on the James River in Charles City, VA.

These impressive facilities encompass a total of 86 acres with over 2,400 feet of deep-water bulkhead that supply access to both the Chesapeake Bay and the Intracoastal Waterway System.

CAPABILITIES

Capable of all facets of marine construction including bridge, pier and bulkhead construction, dredging, dredge material treatment and disposal, stevedoring, heavy lift, marine demolition and salvage, McLean continues to be a staple in marine construction. Combined with an internal team that self-performs millwright, and industrial maintenance and repair services to include welding, material handling equipment repair, equipment, installation and implementation, general facility maintenance and repair, we can offer a safe, single cost-effective solution to all of our client's demands.

ASSETS

McLean's equipment fleet sets us apart from our competition. We have a large fleet of equipment that includes (13) floating cranes/dredges ranging from 35 tons to 250 tons in lifting capacity, (13) crawler cranes ranging from 70 to 200 tons in lifting capacity, (8) work/push boats, (40) barges, (46) pile hammers and (10) hydraulic/truck cranes. Combined with our exceptional relationships with multiple rental outlets we can insure that we will always have the right equipment for the job. Having over 120 employees stationed out of our Chesapeake Regional Office, including a project management and supervision staff comprised of 6 project managers, 7 Field/Project Engineers, 19 superintendents and 27 foremen and over 115 years in the industry, McLean has a staff knowledge base that hard to duplicate.

McLean operates Port Weanack Marine Terminal and Dredge Material Treatment and Disposal Facility in Charles City, VA. This facility includes a 400' sheet pile bulkhead, 300' of dolphins in line with the face of the dock, a 400' x 400' asphalt area behind the dock face, and 26 acres of back-land. Weanack has experience moving a variety of bulk, containerized and other cargos and offers heavy lift operations for specialized cargo as well as laydown areas for storage. With this facility and the ability to treat and dispose contaminated dredge sediments at a fully permitted upland site with a current capacity of over 2,000,000 cubic yards and over 20' of water depth at Mean Lower Low Water, Weanack is a unique and optimal option for many different marine and dredging needs.
